Queensland's energy efficient appliance rebate

Buying a new washing machine, fridge or air conditioner?

Rebates will soon be available for Queensland residents who purchase an eligible appliance on or after 1 January 2018.

Households will be able to apply for one of the following rebates:

- \$200 for a 4-star energy rated washing machine
- \$250 for a 4-star energy rated refrigerator
- \$300 for a 4-star energy rated (for cooling) air conditioner.

Limited to one (1) rebate per household. Funding is limited.

Choosing your appliance

When choosing an appliance – consider which product will best meet your household needs.

To be eligible for a rebate, the appliance must be new and have a minimum 4-star energy efficiency rating.

If you choose to purchase a PeakSmart air conditioner, you may also be able to apply for additional financial benefits available through:

- Energex's **Positive Payback Program** (for south east Queensland customers)
- Ergon Energy's **PeakSmart Program** (for regional Queensland customers).

You should check with your relevant electricity distributor (Energex or Ergon Energy) for the eligibility criteria for their PeakSmart programs as eligibility is separate to the appliance rebate.

Applications will open soon – when can you apply

Applications are not yet open, so make sure you hold onto your receipt to submit with your application. Your receipt or proof of purchase must show payment in full dated on or after 1 January 2018.
