If you are suffering hardship or require emotional support as a result of the Tropical Cyclone, assistance is available. You may be eligible for financial\* or other assistance to help you get back on your feet.

Community Recovery Hubs are a place where residents who are experiencing hardship can apply for grants and obtain emotional and wellbeing support.

Our Community Recovery workers will assist with grant applications and offer referrals to other community organisations and government agencies for further assistance.
