

# CALLING ALL ARTISTS

We're putting the call out to commission an art piece to tell the story of how hepatitis C affects Indigenous communities and what can be done to improve health outcomes.

The art piece will form an essential part of a project led by Hepatitis Queensland that aims to improve workforce knowledge, engage with communities and improve hepatitis C testing rates.

## **How the artwork will be used**

The art piece will be the foundation for all resources and merchandise created for the project. These will be distributed to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health services across Queensland.

## **The Story**

Hep C is silent and many people don't know that they are living with a chronic illness doing damage to their liver – potentially causing liver cancer.

Queenslanders have had access to new hep C treatments since 2016, and half of those living with hep C have been cured.

We need to find all the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who are still living with hep C. This is going to involve people from all areas of health care and the community coming together and working towards elimination.
