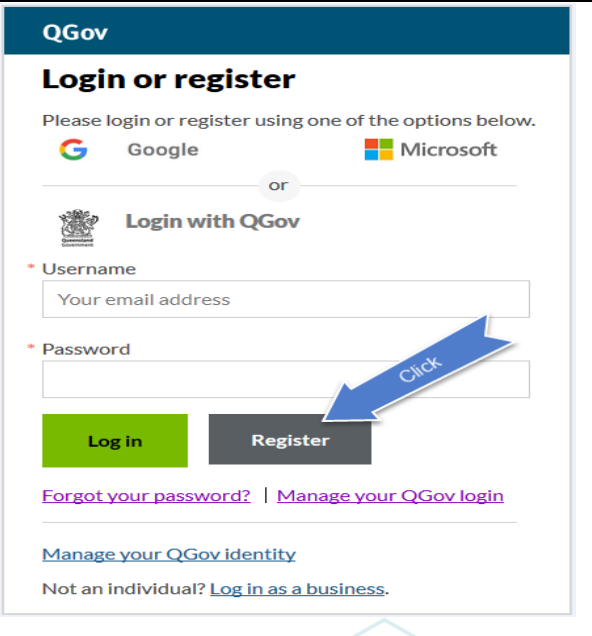
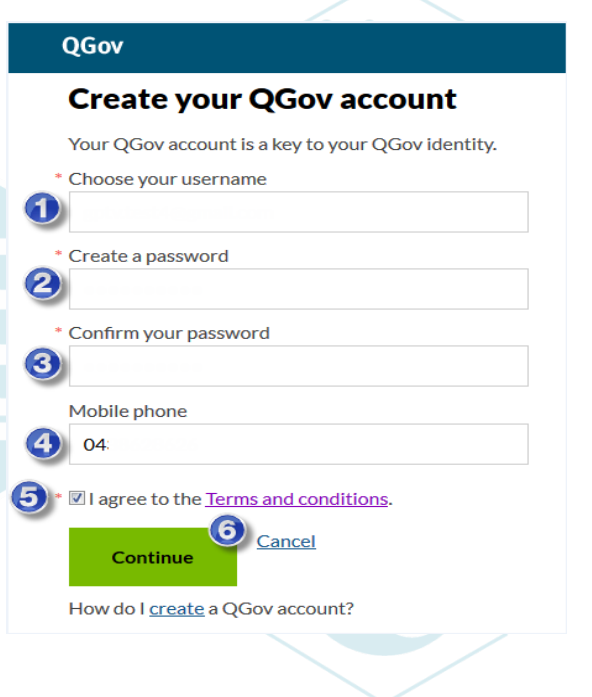
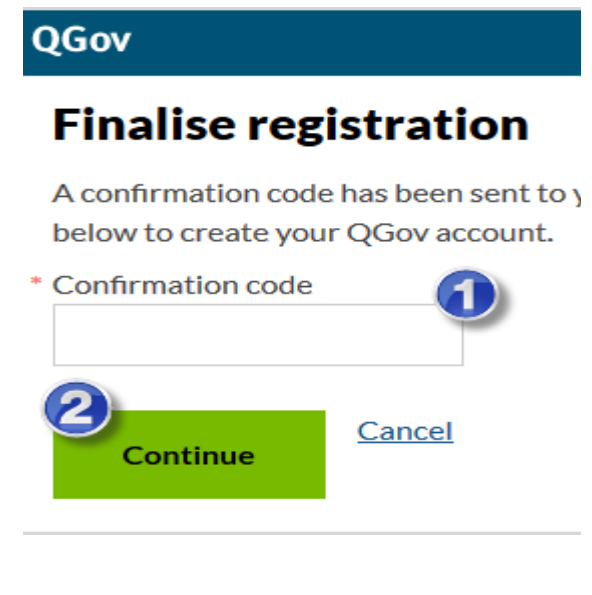
Creating a Health Provider Portal (HPP) account

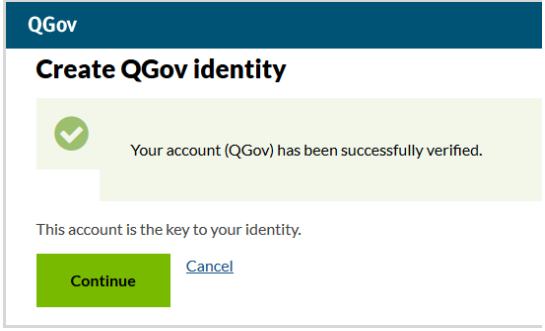
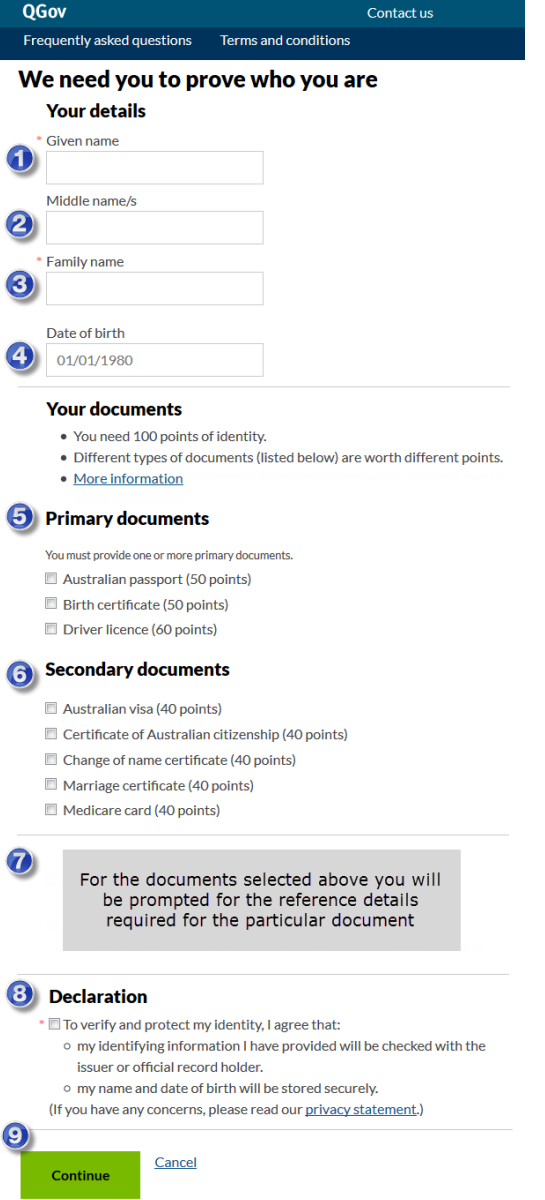
Are you ready for registration?

Do you have the necessary documents ready to register? Do you have your AHPRA details up to date? If not, please refer to Factsheet 1 – Preparing to register for the Health Provider Portal

Creating a HPP account

<p>Step 1</p>	<p>Launch the HPP</p> <p>Open a web browser and enter the URL https://hpp.health.qld.gov.au/ to launch the HPP.</p> <p>🔴* Refer to Fixing Browser Error section on Factsheet 5 if you encounter a problem when trying to launch the HPP.</p>
<p>Step 2</p>	<p>Register your HPP account</p> <p>Click Login with QGov</p> 

<p>Step 3</p>	<p>Create a QGov account</p> <p>Click Register</p>	
<p>Step 4</p>	<p>Create your QGov account</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Enter your individual email address as the Username 2 Create a Password 3 Confirm your Password 4 Enter a Mobile number (this is optional) 5 Check acknowledgement of terms and conditions, then 6 Click Continue <p>Note: An email will be sent with a confirmation code which will need to be entered to complete the creation of the QGov account.</p>	
<p>Step 5</p>	<p>Finalise registration</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Enter the Confirmation code received in the email 2 Click Continue <p>Note: It may take a few seconds before the next page is displayed confirming the QGov account has been successfully created.</p>	

<p>Step 6</p>	<p>Create QGov identity</p> <p>The QGov identity has been successfully verified, click Continue.</p>	
<p>Step 7</p>	<p>Enter your personal identity details</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Enter given name 2 Enter middle name (this is optional) 3 Enter family name 4 Enter date of birth <p>[You need 100 points of identity]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5 Select primary documents preferences (one or more can be selected) 6 Select secondary documents preferences 7 Read Note 8 Read Declaration 9 Click Continue 	

<p>Step 8</p>	<p>Share your personal identity with the HPP</p> <p>From the QGov Share your details page -</p> <p>Select either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Always share ... or 2 Share these personal details with the HPP this time only 3 Click Continue. <p>TIP</p> <p>If you select 'Always share.....' You will not need to share your details every time you sign into the HPP. If you select 'Don't share...' <p>Step 9</p>	<p>Accept the HPP Terms and Conditions</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Check acknowledgement of the terms and conditions, then 2 Click Acknowledge to proceed. 	<p>Terms and Conditions</p> <p>In addition to my obligations under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (Queensland), I understand and agree that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I must access and use the Health Provider Portal (HPP) and access and use information accessible through the HPP ('confidential information') strictly in accordance with the HPP Terms of Access and Use, which I agree forms a legally binding agreement (the 'Agreement') between myself and the State of Queensland acting through Queensland Health ('Queensland Health'); 2. I will not disclose confidential information, except as permitted or required under the Hospital and Health Boards Act 2011 (QH); 3. confidential information, or any part thereof, does not represent an exhaustive and complete health record for any individual; <p>I understand that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. my activities in the HPP are tracked, logged against my login credentials and may be subject to audit, public enquiry and disclosure under the Right to Information Act 2009 (Q4); 2. my access and use of the HPP is monitored, including for identification of breaches of the HPP Terms of Access and Use and inappropriate and unlawful activity; 3. if I breach the HPP Terms of Access and Use, Queensland Health may take action against me under our Agreement; 4. if any of my access or use of the HPP, or my dealing with confidential information; 5. is inappropriate or unlawful, Queensland Health may make a complaint about me under the Health Ombudsman Act 2013 (Q4) and the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (Queensland); 6. breaches legislation; I may be found to have committed an offence and/or be subject to penalties, including up to 500 penalty units under the Hospital and Health Boards Act 2011 (Q4); 7. Queensland Health deals with my personal information collected as a result of my access and use of the HPP in accordance with its Privacy Policy.
