

Patient history details span a person's individual treatment and care delivered at any statewide Queensland Health facility. An expected key benefit will see a reduction in the number of duplicate diagnostic tests and investigations being carried out allowing GP's to reach earlier and/or improved clinical outcomes for their patients.
