Boggo Road station precinct works

As part of building the new Boggo Road underground station, we're upgrading the precinct to integrate the existing Boggo Road surface station, walkways, cycle paths and bus services.

Boggo Road precinct upgrade works will include utility investigation and installation, demolishing asphalt, concrete and kerbs, installing new drainage, kerbs, concrete slabs and paving, reinstatement of the road surface, landscaping and the installation of street furniture.

Works will be undertaken in stages to minimise impacts to precinct stakeholders, road users, pedestrians, cyclists, local property access and public transport services.

To undertake the works safely, temporary traffic and pedestrian changes will be required. This will include staged full road closures and detours.

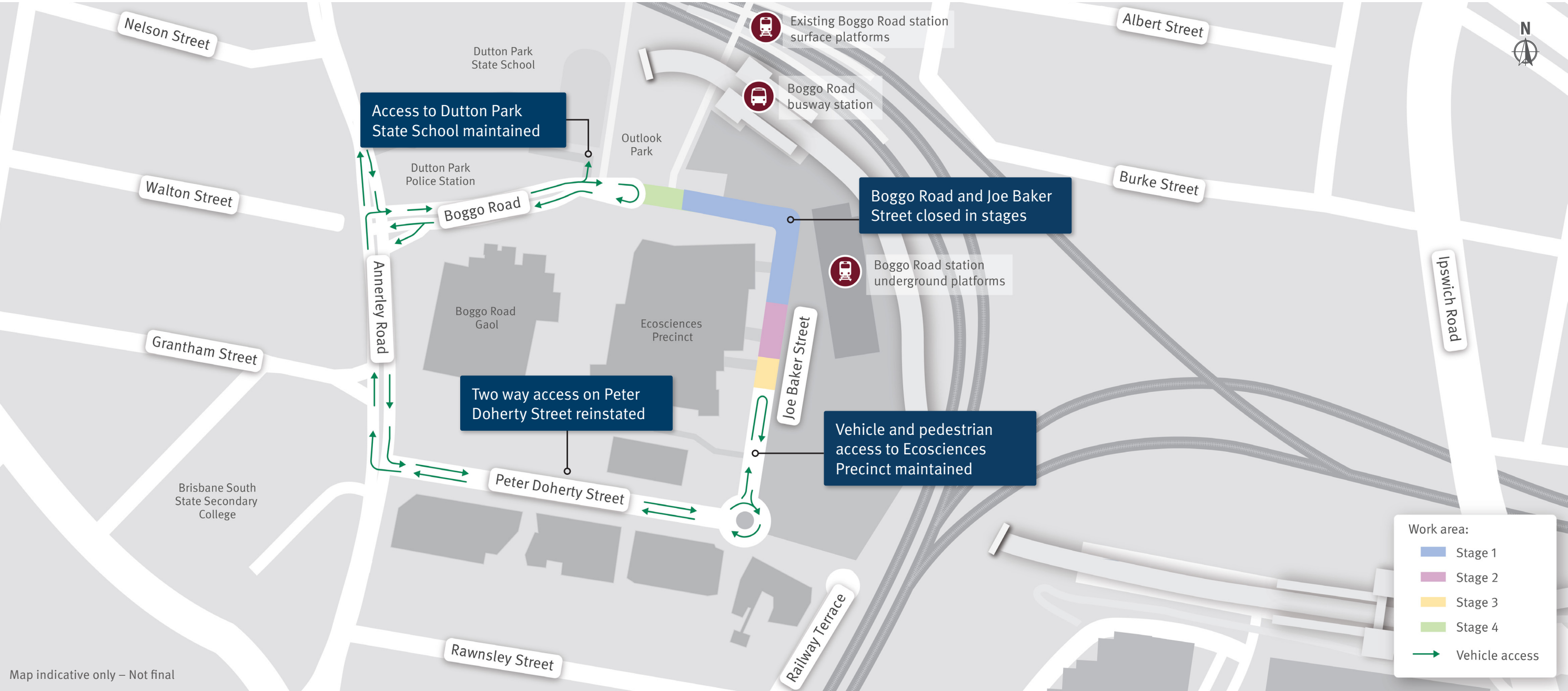

Precinct construction works

Starting from mid-2026 until early 2027, construction activities will be completed in stages to maintain access for local businesses and to Boggo Road station and busway. Work will involve:

Stage 1 Up to 12 weeks	- Full road rebuild - Kerb and channel works - Deep excavation and utility installation across road	Stage 3 Up to 6 weeks	- Full road rebuild - Kerb and channel works - Utility installation across the road
Stage 2 Up to 6 weeks	- Full road rebuild - Kerb and channel works - Deep excavation and utility installation across road - Installation of new utility pit on footpath (ped access changes)	Stage 4 Up to 6 weeks	- Road resurfacing - Kerb and channel works

During each stage, following the completion of utility and road reconstruction works, landscaping and the installation of street furniture will occur progressively across the precinct.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

Temporary work areas will be established within the precinct to safely deliver the works.

While access to Dutton Park State School, Boggo Road station, the Boggo Road busway and local businesses will be maintained, there will be changes to pedestrian and vehicle routes as construction progresses. Please follow detour signage and traffic control advice.

More information will be provided in advance of each stage of construction.

What to expect

- Increased lighting, noise, vibration and dust associated with the use of heavy machinery, road works and equipment
- Traffic delays. Please plan your journey and allow additional time if travelling through the area
- Odours may be noticeable during asphaltting activities.
- Potential impacts to existing services (e.g. power, water, gas) Notification will be provided prior to any impact.
- An increase in construction workers and vehicles.
- Construction activities and associated footpath closures will occur during both day and night shifts (24/7). Works are subject to relevant approvals and suitable weather conditions.
